Day 1 June 6

New ways for new movements among the 35,000 Muslims in the Triangle Area

Pray that God will start a rapidly growing, self-sustaining community of Muslim followers of Jesus in the Triangle area, linked together through strong small “relational groups”, that will take the Good News of the Kingdom of God to the Muslim community of the Triangle area and also to every country they represent in a form that they can understand, readily receive, and enthusiastically embrace.

Day 2 June 7

North Africans in the Triangle

1,200 Moroccans, Algerians, Moroccans Berbers

Pray that God would start several small groups of followers of Jesus among Moroccans and persons of peace would be found to open doors among Algerians.

Day 3 June 8

Pray for dreams and visions of Jesus among Muslims in the Triangle.

Pray for followers of Jesus to come from Apex Mosque.

Day 4 June 9

Pray for breakthroughs among the many West Africans in the Triangle:

Malinke-Mali; Phular/Fulani-Senegal, Niger, & Sierra Leone;

3,500 Wolof-Senegalese; Jola-Senagalese; Yoruba-Nigeria; Hausa-Niger & Nigeria

Day 5 June 10

Pray for breakthroughs among the many West Africans in the Triangle:

Jula-Ivory Coast; Mandinka-Gambian; Bambara-Mali & Burkino Faso;

Susa-Sierra Leone & Guinea; Wolof-Gambian; Bissa-Burkino Faso; Chad

Day 6 June 11

Pray for Christians to engage East Africans in the Triangle with the gospel

Ethiopian-Amharic; Eritrean-Tigrinya; Tanzanian-Swahili; Sudanese

Day 7 June 12

East Africa

Pray for the 775 Somalians to come to know Jesus and be disciples of his.

Day 8 June 13

Pray for small group movements to Jesus among Arabs in the Triangle:

1,471 Egyptians, 460 Jordanians, 1,382 Lebanese, 136 Saudi Arabians, 222 Syrians,

Day 9 June 14

Pray for small group movements to Jesus among Arabs in the Triangle:

Palestinians, Kuwaiti, Arab-Iraq Sunni, Arab-Iraq Shiite

Day 10 June 15

Pray for the Turkic Peoples and Central Asians in the Triangle:

Uzbeks, Kazakhs, Pashtuns-Pakistan & Afghanistan; Baluchi-Pakistan

Day 11 June 16

Pray for the over 1,280 Turks in the Triangle

Pray that Jesus would reveal Himself in dreams and open their hearts to Him.

Day 12 June 17

Pray for breakthroughs among Iranian Shiite-Farsi.

The Ayatollahs have been the best thing to happen to turn Persians or Farsi speakers away from Islam to Jesus. Pray for open doors in the North Raleigh Shiite Mosque.

Day 13 June 18

Dari-Afghani; Tajik

There have been many breakthroughs in Afghanistan; do it here Lord.

Day 14 June 19

Pray for the Western South Asian peoples in the Triangle:

1, 758 Urdu-Pakistan & India

Pray for open doors and dreams and visions in the Cary Mosque (Urdu speakers)

Day 15 June 20

Pray for the Western South Asian peoples in the Triangle: Punjabi Muslims

Day 16 June 21

Pray for 825 people from Bangladesh that people of peace can be found to open doors to speak to them about Jesus.

Day 17 June 22

Pray for the IAR Mosque near NCSU and the Al-Iman school, that Jesus would reveal Himself to key persons of peace and to the leadership of the Mosque. This is the central mosque in Raleigh with the most members and the most influence.

Day 18 June 23

We will spend two days praying for Muslims from Indonesia that Jesus would draw them to Himself and lead people to them to share Jesus.

Day 19 June 24

Pray for Muslims from Indonesia that Jesus would draw them to Himself and lead people to them to share Jesus.

Day 20 June 25

Pray for any Muslims people that we have not listed. For example when praying one day to meet people from unreached people groups in Raleigh, this writer met a Uighur woman coming out of a fabric shop.

Day 21 June 26

Pray that when Muslims in the Triangle read their Quran, they will be drawn to the person of Jesus. May the verses in the Quran about Jesus burn in their hearts and may they have a longing to seek out “peoples of the book” (Jesus followers) to ask them questions.

Day 22 June 27

Pray that as Ramadan is coming to a close the Triangle Muslims would begin to have a deep dissatisfaction in their experience and a deep emptiness in their lives. May verses about Jesus from the Quran keep coming to mind and give them a seeking heart towards Jesus.

Day 23 June 28

Pray for members of the North Raleigh Mosque to have a heart to seek you. In particular pray for this one Palestinian and his family to come to know you.

Day 24 June 29

Pray for recent Muslim immigrants to the Triangle to be able to find jobs, to be able to provide for their families, to learn English and how to survive and thrive in this country. Pray that God would bring Christian friends across their path to help them and walk with them.

Day 25 June 30

Pray for refugees that come to the Triangle will be welcomed, loved and cared for by strong Christians with a heart to serve and bless them with Jesus.

Day 26 July 1

Pray the news about ISIS and all of the terrorist events around the world will turn many Muslims in the Triangle towards Jesus.

Day 27 July 2

Pray for the believers in the Triangle that they will follow and obey the teachings of Jesus to love God with all of their heart, soul, mind and body and that they would love their neighbors as themselves; especially their Muslim neighbors.

Day 28 July 3

Pray that the media propensity to keep up the fear narrative of terrorism would not cast out the love that believers should have for the "Samaritans" among us. Pray that believers in area churches would not think of all Muslims as terrorists but rather as people. 90% of Muslims are people just like us who want security and a good life and hope for their children.

Day 29 July 4

May the Holy Spirit convict any Muslim terrorists in America of their sin and may their sin be found out and their darkness exposed so that there are no more terrorist acts.

Day 30 July 5

Jesus, would You raise up laborers now for this harvest we have prayed for. May our hearts be filled with genuine love for our Muslim neighbors. May our prayers continue until multiple movements have started. Would You open doors and give us boldness and courage to go through. May we be still enough to hear Your voice and then give us the power through Your Holy Spirit to obey. We thank You God for drawing us into Your plans for the nations.
